Seminar Section B Notes

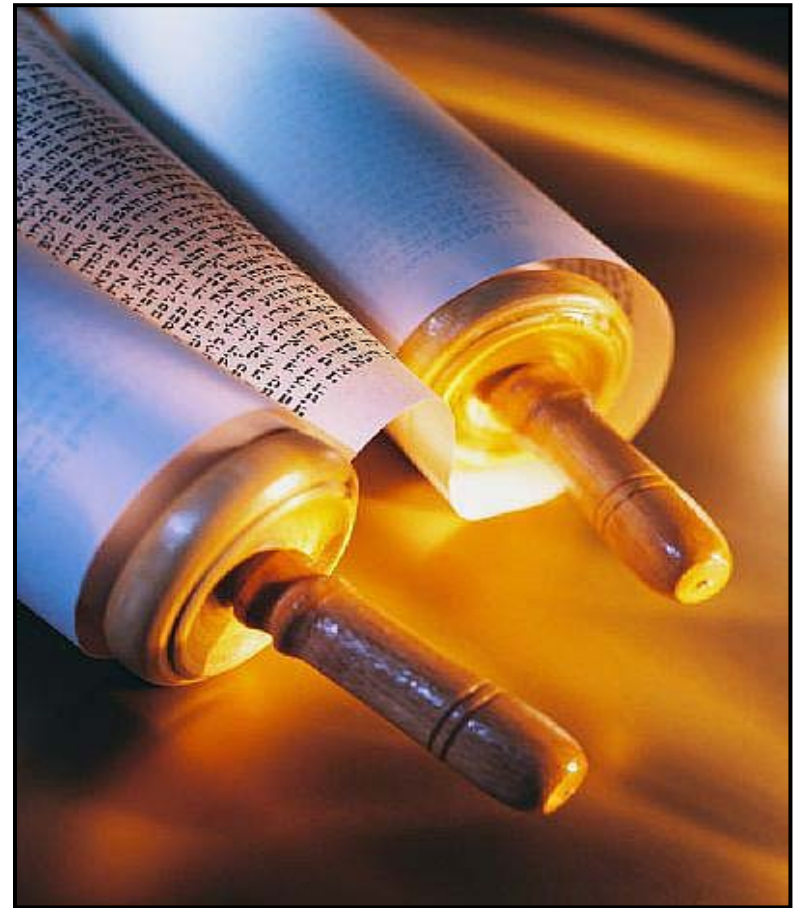

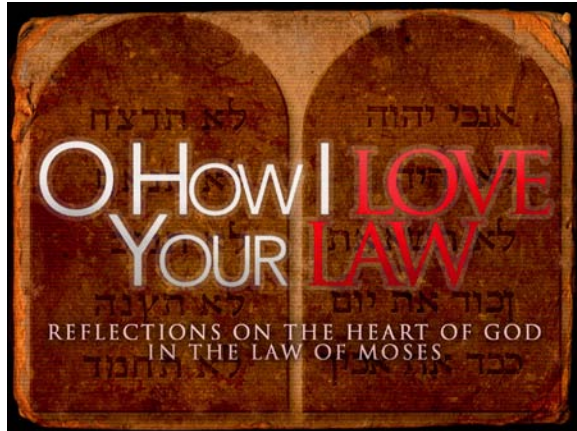

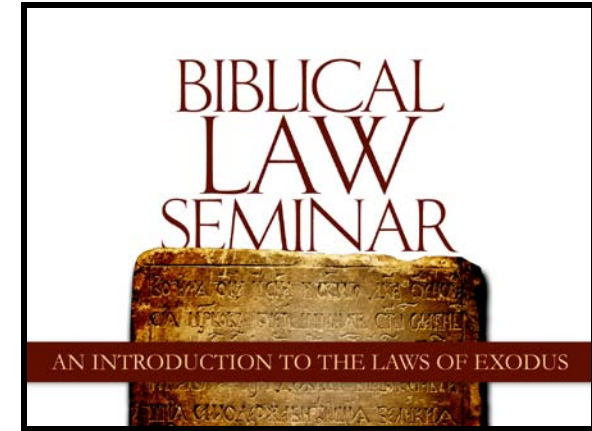
